

PRIZES & LITERATURE REQUIREMENTS

Division I – Grades 7 & 8

Winner – \$300; Runners-up \$150 each

Solo piano, organ or other orchestral instruments.

One classical selection, approximately four minutes in duration.

Division II – Grades 9 & 10

Winner – \$350; Runners-up – \$175

Solo piano, organ or other orchestral instruments.

One classical selection, approximately five minutes in duration.

Division III – Grades 11 & 12

Winner – \$400; Runners-up – \$200

Solo piano, organ or other orchestral instruments.

Two classical selections, each approximately five minutes in length. Contrasting styles are recommended.

Division IV Ensembles – Grades 7-12

Winner – \$450; Runners-up – \$250

Instrumental ensembles – trios through nonets

Two classical selections, each approximately five minutes in length. Contrasting styles are recommended.
