The evening's concert program begins with a special in-person interview between Musicfest's CEO Allan Naplan and Morgan Freeman.







Sixteen-time Grammy Award-winning musician, composer, and producer David Foster joins forces with acclaimed singer and television/Broadway star Katharine McPhee for a special return to Musicfest. This intimate show with the powerhouse duo, joined by classical crossover artist Daniel Emmet (America's Got Talent), will be packed with Foster's hits, featuring music from artists including Chicago, Whitney Houston, Celine Dion, Josh Groban, and Michael Bublé, and McPhee's biggest songs from American Idol, Smash, and Waitress - plus some of their personal favorites!



Joy released her self-titled debut album in 2021, followed a year later by *Linger Awhile*, her breakout Verve debut, of which *Down Beat* Magazine said, "With this beautiful recording, a silky-voiced star is born." The album earned her a Grammy award for Best Jazz Vocal Album in addition to a headline-making win for Best New Artist. In 2025, Joy released *A Joyful Holiday*, which took home Grammys for Best Jazz Vocal Album and Best Jazz Performance.

With over 30 million albums sold, 50 #1 hits, and 160 Gold and Platinum certifications across 35 countries, their impact is undeniable. Since their debut in 2004, the iconic quartet has redefined classical crossover, captivating audiences worldwide with their breathtaking vocals and electrifying performances.

Il Divo By Candlelight will take audiences on a journey through two decades of romance, heartache, and joy, weaving their greatest musical triumphs into an unforgettable evening. They will be joined by string trio Simply Three, who will open the show.

The Texas Tenors return to Musicfest for a highly anticipated concert honoring America's 250th anniversary and featuring some of the trio's best-loved hits. The most successful music group and third highest-selling artists in the history of America's Got Talent, the Tenors' repertoire ranges from country to pop and Broadway to classical. Since originally appearing on AGT in 2009, The Texas Tenors have performed over 2,000 concerts, recorded five studio albums, produced two PBS specials, and have written two hit children's books, earning them impressive recognition including three Emmy Awards and the distinction of being Billboard Magazine's #10 Classical Artist in the World. The Tenors' most recent albums Outside the Lines, Rise and A Collection of Broadway and American Classics all debuted at #1 on the Billboard Charts. Along with appearing on NBC's America's Got Talent: The Champions, they are also filled with pride to have been inducted into the Texas Country Music Hall of Fame.

WHERE MUSIC'S FINEST COME TO PLAY!

ach season, Arizona Musicfest assembles elite musicians from the nation's finest orchestras to perform as the **Festival Orchestra**. Musicfest is proud to present these distinguished artists as part of our Festival Orchestra family.



In a celebratory nod to Musicfest's 35th anniversary, Maestro Robert Moody and the Festival Orchestra perform Mozart's 35th Symphony! The fiery and forceful work features a range of styles, from refined elegance and thunderous pomp to a dazzling finale. Mozart's masterwork is paired with a modern masterpiece, Christopher Tin's *The Drop that Contained the Sea*. The breathtaking, multi-layered and multilingual choral/orchestral work explores the profound significance of water in human experience, through an evocative, global narrative symbolizing both unity and the infinite cycle of life.



In honor of America's sesquicentennial, the **Festival Orchestra** journeys through major eras of our country's history. From the American Revolution and the War of 1812 to the Civil War, the Roaring 20s, and beyond, this concert will explore the music that has become the soundtrack of America for 250 years. Featured works include Copland's monumental *Lincoln Portrait*, as well as selections from Gershwin's iconic *Porgy and Bess*. The concert concludes with patriotic favorites "America the Beautiful" and "The Stars and Stripes Forever".



Following the successful 1908 premiere of Rachmaninoff's Symphony No. 2, the composer was anointed a worthy successor to the great Tchaikovsky. Filled with lush and sweeping melodies, the composer's second symphony is filled with some of the most ravishing melodies Rachmaninoff ever composed. This concert's featured guest soloist is violin virtuoso **Ben Beilman** performing Brahms' Violin Concerto. Acclaimed around the globe, Beilman has won praise both for his passionate performances and deep rich tone which the Washington Post called "mightily impressive."



For our Orchestra Week finale, Musicfest welcomes British pianist **George Harliono** to perform Tchaikovsky's Piano Concerto No. 2. One of the most exciting young pianists on the international scene, Harliono was the Silver Medalist at the 2023 International Tchaikovsky Competition. With *The Planets*, the Orchestra takes us to outer space with the bold and luminous orchestral blockbuster by Holst. The beloved masterpiece describes the seven planets of ancient astrology, each with their own mysterious properties which shape our human lives and characters.
