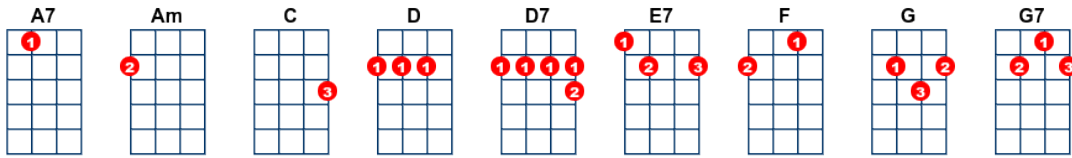


BICYCLE BUILT FOR TWO
