<u>Audition Submission Instructions:</u> (please read carefully)

Note: the roles of Coalhouse, Sarah, Mother, and Tateh will be cast with out-of-town professional performers. Understudies for these roles will be cast locally.

For ADULT roles: auditioners must be 16 and older

For YOUTH roles: auditioners can be between 8-12 years old

- Choose 1-2 vocal sides
 - Option A: Choose from the callback sides in the Google Drive. You can submit for a character you're interested in OR from the general ensemble side. (NOTE: If you are submitting for Emma Goldman, please submit both vocal sides)
 AND, if you would like, you can submit...
 - Option B: Submit an 16-32 bar cut of a song (does not need to be from Ragtime) that highlights your vocal style.
- Choose 1 monologue from the ones provided
- Please prepare your video to be sent as a **SINGLE**, 'unlisted' YouTube, Vimeo, or Google Drive link.
